A standing room only crowd was on hand on a brisk fall day for the 18th annual production sale at Cavenders Neches River Ranch hosted by Cavender, Druggin' M and Partners. 294 registered buyers from 16 states and Mexico packed the stands. Hospitality and fellowship were in abundant supply. The select offering featuring the top cut cattle from each CDP partner met with widespread acceptance and steady demand.

The afternoon's top selling female for \$60,000 was Lot 3, CB MS Benchmark 63D and her good November heifer calf at side. This proven donor leaves 11 daughters in the Cavender Brangus herd. She was purchase by Villa Ranch, Brookshire, TX and sold by Cavender Brangus, Jacksonville, TX.

Lot 2 and 2A, CB MS Icon 63F and her Growth Fund heifer calf were the day's next high seller when American Cattle Enterprise, Oneonta, AL. paid \$37,000 to own the powerful Growth fund heifer, Lot 2A. T3 Brangus, Purvis, MS and Stover Ranch, GA paid \$16,000 to own Lot 2. The pair was sold by Cavender Brangus.

Lot 62, MS DMR Big Lake 535J47 was the third high seller at \$50,000. This big numbered, classy open heifer came from Druggin' M Brangus, Eldorado, AR. She was purchased by Gold Creek Brangus Marietta, GA and Juan Sanchez, Raleigh, NC.

Michael Bennett, Tennessee Colony, TX paid \$45,000 to own Lot 75, WAT MS Empire 1912J10. This thick made wide bodied open heifer was sold by Johnston Brangus, Letohatchee, AL.

Lot 27, CB MS Oracle 415H27 was the fifth high selling heifer when she fetched a bid of \$39,000. This spring bred heifer paints impressive EPD values and a world of rib. She was purchased by Gentica Triple F, Houston TX. She was sold by Cavender Brangus.

Triple T Farms, Fayette Alabama paid \$3,550 for a pen of 5 Brangus Females from Cavenders Neches River Ranch with 60-day old A.I. calves at side sired by CB Masterpiece 2051F and CB Growth Fund 2051G11.

Brangus, Ultrablack and Charolais Bulls from Cavender Draggin' M and Partners attracted a standing room only crowd on a brisk fall day for the 18th annual production sale at Cavenders Neches River Ranch. 294 registered buyers from 16 states and Mexico packed the stands. The Saturday event capped a weekend of great hospitality and comradery along with an elite offering of Brangus genetics. Bulls were offered to fit the needs and price ranges of both registered and commercial customers with 27 prospects selling for \$10,000 and more and 72 bulls selling for \$4,500 or less. The bulls offered were met with glowing reviews and were snapped up at a torrid pace.

The day's \$110,000 high seller was Lot 100, DMR Top Gun 535J19. This calving ease prospect sired by Justified was phenotypically superior with elite carcass credentials. Full possession and ½ semen interest sold to Gustavo Camarena by Draggin' M Ranch, Eldorado, AR.

The second high selling herd sire prospect was Lot 102, PV Frontline 697J2, at \$90,000. GKB Cattle, Desdemona, TX was the purchaser of this big topped, clean sheathed, wide body. He was sold by Platte Valley Brangus, Burden, KS.

Lot 101, CB New Standard 817J3 was tied for the third high selling herd sire prospect when DH Brangus, Gulf Shores, AL and TTT Brangus, Fayette, AL paid \$70,000 to own full possession and ½ semen interest in this powerful Oracle son. He was sold by Cavender Brangus, Jacksonville, TX.

Also selling for \$70,000 was Lot 104, TTT Monument 415J50. ½ Semen interest and full possession in this big ribbed, clean made and powerful Monument son was sold to GKB Cattle. He was sold by TTT Brangus.

Three herd sire prospects were sold for \$30,000. Lot 228, WAT Monument 99J33 sold ½ semen interest and full possession for \$30,000 to The Eagles Ranch, Evergreen, LA. This deep made big bodied prospect was sold by Johnston Brangus, Letohatchee, AL.

Also selling for \$30,000 was Lot 229 as ½ semen interest and full possession of CB Prime Cut 60J30 sold to Hurla Farms, Paxico, KS. This heavy boned carcass king was sold by Cavender Brangus.
